1. Name of the Society	The name of the society shall be “Development Network and Research Foundation”
2. Registered Office	The registered office of the society shall be situated in the National Capital Territory of Delhi; at present it is at Flat No.- 25 D, Pocket D-2, Mayur Vihar Phase-3, Delhi - 110096
3. Working Area	All over India.
4. Aims & Objectives	The aim and objective for which the society is established shall be as under: I) To establish national network and partnership among Public, NGOs, Ministries of States/Central, Government Departments, Development Agencies, Corporates, FICCI like organisations. II) To empower the civil society organisations, government agencies, research and educational Institutions through research, training, survey, awareness, consultancy, RTI etc. Fund raising for other NGOs/programme/this society. III) To increase and create self employment / employment opportunities for rural/urban men/women by upgrading, establishing units, group formation, marketing network etc. IV) To strengthen the PPP (Public Privet Partnership) through meaningful participation of government organization, corporate/private firms/institutions through Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). V) To support the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) through awareness, running projects, capacity building programme, monitoring and evaluation, follow-up, networking nationally etc. VI) To support and put efforts for the implementation of missions/plan of UNDP, World Bank, WHO, DFID, UNICEF, Kendriye Sanik Board (KSB) etc. in India and abroad as well. VII) To cater child rights like child labor, child marriage, primary education, nutrition, police social policy for children, safety, advocacy etc. VIII) To run the women empowerment programmes- health, agriculture, industries, domestic violence and empower socially, economically, legally and politically, supporting the missions of commission for women, UNIFEM etc.

| IX) | To cater the issues related to HIV/AIDS like unsafe sex and low condom use, migration and mobility, widespread stigma, injecting drug use (IDU), low status of women, supporting the missions of NACO, UNAIDS, National HIV/AIDS Alliance, Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation etc. |
| X) | Monitoring, Evaluation of Social Projects and Social Audits of Public Places, Institutions, Offices, New construction etc. for awareness and countermeasures. |
| XI) | To establish, support, maintain, acquire, run, manage institutions, providing basic education at primary, secondary, senior secondary, graduation and post graduation level and institutions providing education and training at various levels in the field of accounting, administration, applied science, architecture, business, commerce, communication, computer, economics, education, electronics, engineering science, Indian languages, environmental science, human resources, information, human rights, RTI etc. All kind of law, management, marketing, social science, mathematics, business administration, nursing, medical, journalism, office management, psychology, sports studies, medicines, teaching tourism, horticulture, humanities, various sciences, sociology, music, veterinary sciences, agriculture science, biochemistry, hotel management, construction and building science, vocational training etc. with the approval of concerned authorities if required. |
| XII) | To assist, to the best of its ability, in establishing institutions and running projects for the rehabilitation of destitute widow, old men and women, the poor, beggars, handicapped, blind, deaf, dumb and mentally disadvantaged persons. |
| XIII) | To do all in its power, by use of lawful steps, to eradicate things such as the dowry system, child marriage, child labour, wastage of money in the various functions and use of intoxicating substances. |
| XIV) | To provide, as far as possible as the Society is able to, monetary and or other relief work, helping the victims of natural calamities and other activities in a manner which will help and uplift the Community in general in times of such calamities. Awareness and training about Disaster Management among community, masses, students, women labours etc. |
| XV) | To open, found establish, promote, set up, run, maintain, assist, finance, support and or help the various community development programs and or activities as well as to assist in the monetary contribution or other assistance in construction, development of community halls, marriage homes, pio, dharamshala, night shelters, |

shochalya, hospitals, prayer halls, health care centers, charitable dispensaries, hospitals, libraries, reading rooms, play grounds, wells, tube-wells, tanks water reservoirs, trees and also to construct and maintain paths, roads, khadanja, bridges, sewerage, stadium (indoor and outdoor) or institutions for the use of and welfare of the general public.

XVI) To engage in social, cultural, educational, moral and spiritual activities or any other activities which contribute to the holistic development of human personality, by establishing, supporting and maintaining schools, colleges, prayer halls, institutions etc., for the benefit of all people without any discrimination of case, creed, nationality, sex, religion or community

XVII) To subsidies or reimburse traveling expenses, or cost of board and lodging to students, who need to travel, in order to advance their educational skills. To bring other scholars from around the globe and provide a forum for academic, spiritual and social development.

XVIII) To offer prizes, award scholarship, issue certificates, diplomas and degrees as the Society sees fit to deserving students and to offer all possible facilities to the students who are interested to go abroad for higher education.

XIX) To offer full co-operation and assistance to benevolent schemes which are in accordance with the objects of the Society. Such schemes, whether undertaken by the State or Central Government or by public or private enterprises or religions or philanthropic organizations of bodies are to be supported, as far as possible by the society.

XX) To establish, set up, run, promote, maintain, finance and support hospitals, charitable dispensaries, mobile dispensaries, ambulances, maternity homes, maternity clinic, child welfare centres, convalescent homes, sanatoriums, hostels and other similar institutions or facilities for provision of medical relief.

XXI) To establish clinics and centers for the education of women and men in family planning matters/RCH to education of women and men in family and care in situations where pre-natal and post-natal depression and other related symptoms arise.

XXII) To promote campaigns by lawful means in order to educate, discourage and in all other ways possible the dependence of the public in alcohol, drugs and other addictive substances.



XXIII) To bring awareness to the public on matters relating to preserving

- the environment. Providing students/masses/manufacturing units with training on the harmful effects of pollution and other practices, otherwise detrimental to public welfare.
- XXIV)** To encourage participation in projects of re-afforesting, cleaning and maintenance of clean waterways, control of air pollution etc. Organisation of camps, plantation, seminars, gatherings and adopting other teaching skills on management and preservation of the pollution free environment.
- XXV)** To encourage society/industries to become more anti-pollution aware by granting awards, certificates etc. for special efforts exercised by them in pollution control in residential, industrial and rural areas.
- XXVI)** To organize the development of the arts. To promote music, song and play performances. To encourage painting, pottery, sculpture, writing and poetry and other talents in the field of the humanities.
- XXVII)** To assist in developing effecting communication between Government, Semi-Government, National Agencies etc. and the general public. To collect information, notice etc. from these source and provide it to the members of society and the general public.
- XXVIII)** To publish books, charts, illustrations, journals, magazines, periodicals, news-letters, newspapers and other publications and periodicals in different language and on different subjects.
- XXIX)** To use television, radio, literature, internet, correspondence courses, satellite or satellite disk or other apparatus, including internet connection etc. for the purpose to educate society in understanding welfare, community health, development, spiritual appreciation, family life, human rights and a lifestyle that will help improve the society in general.
- XXX)** To establish and maintain contract and co-operate with other institutions, organizations, in and outside India, having similar objects of this Society. If the need arise, this society is empowered to take over such institutions, organisations and carry on the affairs of such bodies under the regulations of the society.
- XXXI)** To receive Indian volunteers with various skills to assist, help, aid and participating to fulfill the objects of the society.
- XXXII)** To activities and branches shall be spread all over India and also into different countries of the world with the approval of CBDT if required.

- XXXIII)** To make correspondences in lawful manner to arrange meetings, conferences, seminars with the concerned government authorities for the solution of social/civic problems of members of the society and general public.
- XXXIV)** To promote the interest of people in environment, sense of integration, self employment, family planning, sanitation section by making audio visual, Tele Films, T.V. Serials and documentary on various aspects of culture music, crafts, environment, health, education, sports and place of social integration. The society will also organize the stage plays, musical concerts, self help group, seminars and variety programmes on special occasions.
- XXXV)** To establish and maintain institutions for the handicapped, disabled, blind, poor, child labor, SC & ST, BC, OBC and minority classes and other needy persons like vocational training of house hold industries, semi-skilled jobs for self employment and to provide food, clothing, mid day meals, medical and transpirations, libraries, laboratories, reading rooms, hotels, playgrounds, swimming pool and other required facilities to the boys/girls and also to the members of the society.
- XXXVI)** To promote conscious, educational/welfare and treatment, programs to control the HIV/AIDS, Cancer, Diabetes, Leprosy, Tuberculosis, Syphilis, Heart, Skin and other Diseases.
- XXXVII)** To create a forum for Senior Citizens where they can exchange their various views and experiences, which may be, make available to younger generation.
- XXXVIII)** To undertake road safety programs and help police and Traffic police, to control vehicles and social evils on the road.
- XXXIX)** To acquire by purchase, lease, gift, grant, legacy, bequest, exchange or otherwise from any person, company, government or institutions whatsoever, lands, buildings, motor vehicles and all other kinds of properties both movable and immovable for the attainment of the objects of the Society. Also to construct, improve, alter and extend any buildings, chowpals that may be found necessary for the purpose of the society.
- XL)** To participate in the affiliation, accreditation, examination and certification.
- XLI)** To coordinate participation of social partners, employers in the private sector, training providers, professional societies and NGOs/civil society groups in the process of skill development of the

- XLII)** To identify the skill development needs of the Sector, review national trends in Sector skill development and identify Sector skill gaps and technology.
- XLIII)** To promote and setup digital/smart classes, digital literacy, thinker lab, science center/lab, digital library, teacher's capacity building programme.
- XLIV)** To become a member of any association of any of the councils as may be required for skill development in the Sector or any sector skill councils as and when formed by NSDC and adhere to the charter of such councils.
- XLV)** To facilitate and assist the Appropriate Governmental Authority and NSDC in strengthening the existing vocational education system for skill development in the Sector and to collaborate in upgrading vocational training system in the Sector, in line with requirements to achieve global standards in manpower productivity.
- XLVI)** To Promote research work related to Science and Technology with the financial support of the state and central govt./ national bodies/corporates.

All the incomes, earnings, movable and immovable properties of the society shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of the aims and objects only as set forth in the memorandum of association and no profit on thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits in any manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the society or to any person claiming through anyone or more of the present or the past members. No member of the society shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the society or make any profits, whatsoever by virtue of this membership.
